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What is the distinction between a Catholic priest and a Protestant minister? In the Catholic Church, the priest is ordained to perform the sacraments, especially the Eucharist, and to act in the person of Christ. In the Protestant tradition, the minister is ordained to preach the Word and administer the sacraments, but the emphasis is on the Word and the sacraments as means of grace. The Catholic priest is also responsible for the pastoral care of his flock, while the Protestant minister is often more involved in the governance of the church.
