

William of Ockham (c. 1287–1347) of the University of Paris, writing in his  
Summa Theologiae (c. 1296–1302), argued that the papal claim to universal jurisdiction  
was a usurpation of God's authority. He argued that the pope's power was limited to  
temporal matters and that the church should be subject to the civil law of the state.  
His ideas were influential in the development of the concept of the separation of  
church and state. Ockham's nominalist philosophy also influenced the development of
